The Léal Vineyards *Godsend* is made from select lots of the 2005 Estate Cabernet Sauvignon. The selected lots received extended barrel aging of seventeen months in a blend of French and American Oak and an additional six months in brand new heavy toasted American oak barrels. This additional six months of aging give the wine added complexity and depth. The sophistication of this wine is apparent with the first sip. The nose is full of aromas of rich currant, vibrant blackberry and notes of toasty oak. This is an elegant, balanced and well structured wine with a long rounded finish. This limited production is intended to be enjoyed with the best of friends and family in the celebration of life.
