This selection received extended barrel aging of eighteen months in French oak. The wine was carefully racked and moved to new American oak barrels for an additional four months, lending to even greater complexity. Extended bottle aging creates soft tannins and an extremely memorable experience upon release. The approachability, structure, intensity, and drawn out finish make “Godsend” a sought after hedonistic treasure. Intense flavors of cassis, black cherry, cocoa powder and mocha melt in your mouth with creamy, velvety texture. Enjoy with your favorite people in the celebration of life.
