Winemaker “Griff”: “Lavánda Meritage is a very small production blend focusing on lots of juicy red fruit from Merlot, structure and tannin from Cabernet Sauvignon, and spice and earth from the Cabernet Franc. The finish has a toasty element that really stays with you. Lavánda is a good match with bbq ribs, lamb, or a juicy porterhouse steak.”
