THE 2006 LÉAL VINEYARDS ESTATE CABERNET SAUVIGNON HAS A DEEP RUBY COLOR WITH A SEDUCTIVE NOSE. THE FRUIT EXPLODES FROM THE GLASS AND IS UNDERSCORED BY A TOASTED OAK THAT FOLLOWS WITH COMPLEX, LAYERED FLAVORS, SUPERB STRUCTURE AND SILKY TANNINS. THIS WINE OFFERS ABUNDANT QUANTITIES OF BLACK CURRANTS, COCOA, PLUMS, BLACKBERRIES AND CASSIS. THE MID-PALATE IS PLUSH AND SAVORY WITH A FINISH OF SWEET TANNIN AND FRUIT. A GREAT MATCH FOR A HEARTY STEAK OR LAMB CHOPS.
