The 2006 Estate Grown Threesome is our risqué and delicious take on the marriage of three classic Rhone red varietals: Syrah, Grenache, and Mourvedre. The name reflects both the sexy nature of this wine and our philosophy to always challenge the existing status quo.

Comprised of 66% syrah, 25% grenache and 9% mourvedre, this wine has a gorgeous nose of ripe blackberry fruit, cassis, milk chocolate and baked cherry. Fabulous depth and fresh acidity help create a full-bodied wine that is layered with complexity and flavor.
